## 2017 KENTUCKY STATE SENIOR BOWLING TOURNAMENT RULES

- This shall be an United States Bowling Congress (USBC) sanctioned six game tournament open to all members of local associa-1. tions sanctioned by the USBC within the State of Kentucky who are 50 years of age, or older, with winners being determined by the bowler's actual score, plus handicap based on 90% of the difference in the bowler's entering average and 220. The bowler will bowl six games in the tournament in one of four offered time slots. USBC Rules and Regulations shall govern this tournament.
- Bowlers, if requested, must present their 2017-18 senior or regular USBC membership card prior to bowling. Individuals with-2. out USBC Membership are eligible to participate in this tournament by paying affiliate membership dues up to a maximum of \$21. See USBC Rule 300c.
- Entrants may compete once in a class based on their age as of midnight September 1, 2017. Classes are as follows: Super Sen-3. ior-75 years or older, Class A-70 to 74, Class B-65-69, Class C-60 to 64, Class D-55 to 59 and Class E-50 to 54.
- Bowlers entering average, which will be used to determine handicap will be as follows: 4.
  - Bowlers highest 2016-17 average based on 21 games or more rolled in any USBC sanctioned league, including summer a. (see USBC Rule 319a-1).
  - b. If no acceptable 2016-17 average was established, use September 1, 2017 USBC sanctioned league average, based on 21 games or more.
  - If no acceptable average under 4a or 4b, a bowler may use his highest USBC sanctioned 21 games or more average for c. the 2015-16, 2014-15, 2013-14 or 2012-13 season in that order.
  - d. A bowler with no previous league or tournament average shall be accepted at no less than 170.
  - e. USBC Rule 319c shall apply to this tournament and bowlers who may qualify for re-rating must present their tournament scores prior to bowling.
  - f. Bowlers are not required to report previous tournament winnings in accordance with USBC Rule 319d.
- The ten pins over average rule has been waived for this tournament. 5.

- 6. Prize ratio is one for each five entries in each age classification. Prize fund to be returned 100%. The champion, or winner, in each age classification will be eligible to represent the State of Kentucky at the 2018 USBC Senior Championships at a site to be determined later.
- There will be no additional cost of entry fees to the bowler who qualifies for the USBC Senior Championships. The entry fee 7. and shirt fee will be paid by the Kentucky State USBC Bowling Association. Nominal expenses (not all) will also be paid upon successful completion of the USBC Senior Championships. In the event a qualifier is unable to participate in the USBC Senior Championships, the next highest bowler who rolled in the same classification of the Kentucky State Senior Bowling Tournament will be eligible to participate in the USBC Senior Championships.
