TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This will be a USBC certified singles tournament for senior bowlers who are members of the KSBA, Division classifications will be determined by the age of the bowler at the time of bowling her first series in the Senior Championship Tournament. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify her age division. Incorrect classifications will disqualify her scores. Corrections can be made to the tournament manager prior to completion of the bowler's first series.
- 2. USBC rules and regulations shall govern this tournament. Each bowler must present her USBC membership card prior to time of bowling.
- 3. Entrants are to compete only once. There will be no substitutions allowed. There will be no refund of entry fees after deadline
- 4. This shall be a singles six game handicap tournament with the winner being determined by the bowler's actual score plus a handicap based on 100% of the difference of the bowler's entering average and 200 for a six game series.
- 5. The entering average for each bowler participating in the tournament shall be used for handicap purposes as follows:
 - (a) Bowler's highest average for the 2017-2018 season based on 21 or more games rolled in any sanctioned league. An average established in the 2017 summer league shall be accepted as official, provided the bowler does not have an acceptable regular season average.
 - (b) If no 2017-2018 average, use highest current average based on a minimum of 12 games by tournament bowling date.
 - (c) A bowler who has no previous league or tournament average shall be accepted at no less than a 180 average.
- 6. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of her entering average. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify scores if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in a greater handicap. Prize monies shall be based on submitted average if it is higher than actual average. Corrections in average can be made up to the completion of the series if the tournament manager, prior to the completion of the first game of the series, has been given written consent to the bowler authorizing such an extension of time to correct the average.
- 7. Prize ratio shall be one for each five entries in each division. Top finisher in each division of Classes Super Senior, A, B, C, D and E qualifies to represent Kentucky in the USBC National Seniors Championship Tournament in 2018. If unable to attend, the runner-up in that division will be offered the opportunity to represent Kentucky. The fee for the one participant in each division of the USBC National Seniors Tournament shall be paid by the KSBA and will not come out of the prize monies portion of this tournament. The \$200.00 expense allowance for each participate going to the National Tournament will come out of the expense fee division of the tournament. THIS WILL BE PAID UPON RECEIPT OF EXPENSE MAILED TO THE KSBA ASSOCIATION MANAGER WHEN YOU RETURN. In the event of a tie for first place in any division, the bowler with the highest game with handicap will be declared the champion. If a tie still exists, the second highest game with handicap will be used, etc. In the event of a tie for other places, the monies for the tied places will be combined and divided equally. In the event of a tie for eligibility in the USBC National Seniors Championship Tournament, the high game with handicap rule shall apply for tied places.
- 8. Three (3) games shall be rolled each shift. Bowlers may roll six (6) straight games by signing up for two consecutive shifts or bowl three (3) games on Saturday and three (3) games on Sunday.
- 9. The Board of Directors of the KSBA shall have the power to hear and act on all protest pertaining to this tournament.
- 10. USBC Rules 319A-2, 319D and 319E shall not apply to this tournament.
